- Pray for an end to the Covid-19 pandemic. Pray for the Westminster and devolved governments and the scientists advising their response. Pray for the world, especially those other countries most badly hit, such as the USA, India, Brazil, Italy and S. Africa.
- Pray for the poorest countries of the world who cannot afford the vaccine, have limited medical staff to respond to the pandemic, and are reliant on international aid. Pray for the COVAX programme, designed to provide the vaccine to these countries.
- Pray for NHS staff. For those who are under such pressure, for those who are ill themselves. for long term psychological healing of the trauma they have endured.
- Pray for those who are in hospital for their recovery; pray for those grieving the loss of loved ones; pray for those awaiting delayed medical procedures and tests.
- Pray for the vaccination process and staff, for a constant supply and efficient delivery of both doses and for its effectiveness. Pray for those producing the vaccine including the production facility in Wrexham recently affected by flooding.
- Pray for Bethshan nursing home, manager Sylvia and the trustees, staff, and residents. Pray for other nursing and care homes including those in Newtown.
- Pray for those at Hope facing sickness, including terminal diagnosis, medical treatment, and tests. Pray for others you know of who need healing.
- Pray for the mental health of the nation, and for deliverance from fear.
- Pray for Hope and the church across the country to be at the forefront of healing in communities, mental, physical, and emotional. Pray for a greater manifestation of healing gifts in the church.
